

~General Information For All Campers~

Camp fees cover all meals, lodging and program activities. Spending money is optional for camp photos, ropes course, camp CD or purchases from the camp store. Our camp store will offer candy, sodas and a few clothing items such as hats, tee shirts, and sweat shirts. Please see the store price list below to determine the appropriate amount of money to bring. Check-in for campers is from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon. Please arrange to depart from camp between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following Saturday morning. Because Saturday is a travel day for the staff we strongly urge parents to pick up campers on time. Thank you!

Your family insurance plan is the primary source of coverage for any accidents that may occur during your time at camp. A copy of your medical insurance card (front & back) **MUST** be attached to the Registration & Medical form and be on file in the camp office **BEFORE** you arrive for your camp session. **All medications (both over-the-counter and prescription drugs) brought to camp MUST come in their original container with pharmacist's label (for prescription meds) containing doctor's orders.**

Care Package Shipping Information:

All care packages for campers should be sent United Parcel Service for timely delivery! Packages & letters for campers may be brought directly to the camp office during Check-in on Sunday afternoon & left for delivery through inter-camp mail.

Remind them to write their return address on each piece of mail, even postcards, so if the mail doesn't arrive in time to be delivered to you, it can be returned to the sender.

For a small fee, emails can be sent to you in care of campers@pccci.org. Be sure the sender writes your full name and camp name (i.e. Big bear or Rancho La Scherpa) in the Subject line of the message. There is a .50 fee for *each* email sent to you.

What To Bring

(Please mark all of your belongings with your full name)

- ~Bible, pencil & notebook
- ~Sleeping bag & pillow (bed & mattress furnished)
- ~Extra blanket & warm jacket suggested for cold weather
- ~Flashlight, Mosquito repellent & sun block!
- ~ toilet articles including soap, towel, shampoo, etc
- ~Suitable clothing, two pairs of sturdy shoes & plenty of socks for camping & hiking
- ~Modest swimsuit, towels, fishing gear, etc.

What To Leave At Home

- ~Sandals, pets, radios, electronic games, cell phones, cassette, MP3, or CD players.
- ~No tobacco products, drugs, alcoholic beverages or weapons **of any kind...** **Please note**, campers caught with such items may be sent home early, at the parents expense.
